To Make BOO Card:

Quick Note:

The banner actually hangs down. Attached by the bows it seems more petite.

Supplies:

- 1/2 sheet whisper white card stock
- 1/2 sheet Early Espresso card stock
- 1/4 sheet Old Olive card stock
- 2" x 3" piece Daffodil Delight card stock
- 2" x 3" piece Whisper White cardstock
- 2" x 3" piece Tangerine Tango card stock
- 4" Whisper White Taffeta Ribbon
- 18" White Baker's Twine
- Two 3" pieces White Baker's Twine
- Big Shot
- Die Cut Letters- Billboard
- Perfect Polka Dots embossing folder
- Soft Suede Inkpad
- Sponge
- Petite Pennants Builder Punch
- 1/16" circle punch
- Scissors
- Adhesive
- Paper Cutter with Score Blade



Assembly:

- Score Whisper White card.
- Cut an Early Espresso mat to 4" x 5 1/4", adhere to card and set aside.
- Cut Old Olive mat to 3 3/4" x 5".
- Run Old Olive mat through Big Shot using the Perfect Polka Dots embossing folder.
- Sponge Old Olive Mat and set aside. DO NOT ADHERE TO CARD.
- Punch 3 scalloped pennants in Early Espresso, set aside.
- Punch 3 triangle pennants each in Tangerine Tango, Whisper White and Daffodil Delight.
- Trim 1/3 off each Daffodil Delight triangle and adhere to Whisper White triangles.
- Trim 2/3 off each Tangerine Tango triangle and adhere top layer to triangle.
- Adhere candy corn to Early Espresso scalloped triangles.
- Attach letters.
- Punch holes in the top corners of each triangle and thread onto a 12" piece of White Baker's Twine
- Tie a bow in each end of Baker's twine. Set aside.
- Punch holes in each side of Old Olive card stock roughly 1" from the top and 1/8" in on each side.
- Using the 3" pieces of Baker's twine, make a loop from front to back through each hole.
- Carefully slide the center of each bow through the loops to hold in place. Pull taut and adhere 3" ribbon to back to hold in place.
- Adhere Old Olive card stock to card front.
- Add Taffeta bow to top center of card to complete.
