

Casket Candy Tutorial

Materials:

- about ½ sheet cardstock
- Paper trimmer
- Score Blade
- Scissors
- Adhesive
- Stamps
- Velcro or ribbon
- Ruler



Instructions:

1. Cut paper to 8 ½" x 2 ¾". (You will get 4 of these from one 8 ½ x 11 paper.)
 - Score at 4", 4 ¼", and 4 ½".
 - Fold in half.
 - Trim corners as follows: Mark ¾" in on top and 1" down. Cut diagonally on both top corners. For the bottom corners mark ½" in, and cut to the top diagonal 1" mark. (I was able to easily cut through both layers with the paper trimmer.)
 - TIP: Make a template at this point if producing more than one.
2. Cut insert piece to 1 ¾" x 2 ¾". (I use the same color cardstock.) (You will get 16 of these from one 8 ½ x 11 paper.)
 - Score at ½", 1 ¾", 2", 2 ¼".
 - Fold on the 2" mark. (The middle of 3.)
 - Trim ¼" in from each side down to the score mark, making a 1 ¼" x ½" hole for candy.



3. Stamp pieces with images or backgrounds.

4. Place adhesive on both ½” tabs on the insert piece.

- Adhere bottom tab on the center (bottom of casket) of base piece.
- Adhere back tab about ¾” up from bottom. Remember to line up the top when doing this.

5. Place Velcro or ribbon closure at the top.

6. Embellish as desired.
